Men's Soccer Back in Win Column Versus Andrew College

First year head coach Bart Sasnett was victorious Saturday versus his Alma mater and former employer Andrew College. The 5-1 victory improves the Cavaliers record to 6 wins and 3 losses on the season. The Cavaliers controlled the match throughout, leading 2-0 at the half. The Cavs offense was led by Andrew College transfer Karl Roesch with 2 goals. Additional scoring was provided by Yuki Kariya (1 goal, 3 assists), Seve Llama (1 goal, 1 assist), and Ryan Putala (1 goal). The Cavaliers return to action Tuesday versus Middle Georgia at 5pm.

DC Golf Finishes Second Behind Georgia Southwestern in GSW Fall Hurricane Classic

Georgia Southwestern Blue's defeated Darton College for the GSW Fall Hurricane Classic championship Sunday. Georgia Southwestern, a member of NCAA Division II, defeated Darton College by 10 strokes.

Georgia Southwestern and Darton each entered two teams in the tournament.

Darton's Red team, which was second with a 576, was led by Chesley Gunn (71-72-143) and Ridge Purcell (73-70-143), who tied for third individually. Jin Chung (71-74-145) finished fifth. Chung, Gunn, and Purcell were named to the All-Tournament Team. Coleman Calhoun was tied for seventh (75-72-147), followed by J.P. Putnam (T-12th, 73-76-149).

"I felt like we played sort of mediocre this weekend," said Darton coach Dale Dover, whose Red team trailed by 11 shots after the first day. "The course is real short, and I just felt like we didn't play great and Georgia Southwestern played well. We've basically got to have some players step up and play like No. 1, 2 and 3 seeds."

Darton's Gray team (606) placed fourth and was led by Andy Lewis (T-10th, 76-72-148), Evan Hanna (T-14th, 77-73-150), Aaron Elrod (17th, 77-76-153) and Matt Smith (T-19th, 81-74-155).

Darton Baseball Wins One of Two from CVCC

The Darton Baseball team split a doubleheader on 9-18 against CVCC from Phenix City Alabama. In game 1, the Cavs were unable to hold a one run lead in the 7th inning. Taylor Whitenton and Trent Dooly had two hits each to pace the Cavs offense. In game 2, the Darton offense erupted for 11 runs and held off the Pirates for an 11-7 victory. Darton finished the game with 10 hits. The spit evens the Cavaliers fall record at 2-2.
