## 2<sup>nd</sup> Ranked Lady Cavaliers Extend Record to 12-0-1

The Lady Cavalier soccer team improved its season record to 12-0-1 following easy victories at South Georgia College on Wednesday and home versus Truett-McConnell on Saturday. The Lady Cavaliers combined for 19 goals in the two games while only conceding one. Stephanie Daniels, the nations leading scorer, continues to lead the offensive attack. Stephanie has accrued 30 goals and 12 assists for 72 total points. Not far behind Stephanie is the 4<sup>th</sup> leading scorer in the country Cherrelle Albert. Cherrelle has accumulated 25 goals and 10 assists for 60 points on the season. Lindsey Warner and Lauren Wheatley are also amongst the top 50 scorers nationally with 31 and 25 points respectively.

## Darton Golfers Back to Winning Ways

The Darton College golfers rebounded from their second place finish at the Georgia Southwestern Hurricane Invitational to win the MGCCC Fall Invitational in Gulfport Mississippi last week. After sitting in 5<sup>th</sup> place after the first day the Cavaliers shot the low score of the 2<sup>nd</sup> round and never relinquished their lead. The Cavaliers (+25) finished first overall, followed by Wallace State (+33), Mississippi Gulf Coast (+38), Central Alabama (+46), and Faulkner State CC (+47) rounded out the top five.

Individually Darton College's J.P. Putnam finished at the top of the leader board with a 2 under par for the event. Other Cavalier golfers in the top 20 were Jin Woo Chung (6<sup>th</sup> place, +8), Chesley Gunn (11<sup>th</sup> place, +9), Coleman Calhoun (13<sup>th</sup> place, +10), and Andy Lewis (16<sup>th</sup> place, +12).

## Men's Soccer Drops Pair

The Darton College Men's Soccer team saw their record drop to 8-5 overall following a home loss to Truett McConnell on Saturday. The loss is the first time this season the team has dropped consecutive matches having seen their three game winning streak snapped earlier in the week in a loss at South Georgia College on Wednesday. The team, currently in 3<sup>rd</sup> place in the South Sub Region, will be back in action traveling to Andrew College on Sunday.

## Region Championships Next For Cross Country

The Darton College Men's and Women's Cross Country teams ran into some stiff competition at a challenging course on Saturday during the Disney World Classic in Orlando, Florida. Brittney Skiles was Darton's top finisher on the ladies side, finishing in 89<sup>th</sup> place overall out of more than 360 competitors. Region XVII 2<sup>nd</sup> ranked runner Tabitha Payne finished 126<sup>th</sup>. As a team the Lady Cavaliers finished in 30<sup>th</sup> place out of the 40 teams competing.

On the Men's side David Marley again was Darton's top finisher with a placing of 95<sup>th</sup> out of more than 300 competitors. Nicholas Felder was Darton's second finisher coming in 145<sup>th</sup> overall. As a team the Cavaliers placed 32<sup>nd</sup> out of 41 total teams competing.

Although the course was challenging and a bit sloppy due to the weather conditions, Darton will look to improve upon their results in the upcoming Region Championships scheduled for October 20<sup>th</sup> in Cleveland, Georgia.
