Women's Cross Country Team Concludes Inaugural Season at National Meet

The Darton College Lady Cavalier Cross Country team completed its first season of competition with a 29th place finish at the NJCAA Championship meet in Rend Lake Illinois.

Four DC runners had their best races Saturday – Tabitha Payne, Danielle Sumner, Juawana Stringer and Kathryn Higgins.

Below are comments contributed by Coach David Mann:

Danielle recorded her best time, and she may be the only Darton College student-athlete to participate in the national championship for two different sports (soccer and cross country).

Juawana came from one of my "Walk, Jog or Run for Fitness" classes and has worked hard all season; her time of 22:04 is a tremendous accomplishment for her, as this is more than ten minutes faster than her first race this season. She has become a strong competitor now, and she will have an important role in helping us win region next year. The entire team is very proud of her.

Tabitha Payne set a new school record Saturday. I am very pleased with her efforts. She has raced well all season.
