Golf Three-peat Named Sports Story of the Year

The Darton College golf team's third consecutive NJCAA golf championship has earned Sports Story of the Year for 2007 as selected by the Albany Herald sports writers. In 2007 Head Coach Dale Dover and the DC golf team won their third consecutive NJCAA D2 Golf National Championship. Darton's three consecutive championships are second only to Tyler Junior College who won an extraordinary 5 consecutive titles from 1994 to 1998.

The team's quest for a fourth consecutive championship continues on February 2nd at the Titan Invitational in Melbourne Florida.
